Team Swim Caps ALL swimmers, boys and girls, MUST be in a team swim cap during swim meets.

NAC will provide each swimmer with one latex swim cap as part of their registration. Additional latex or silicon caps can be purchased for an additional fee at registration while supplies last. Personalized LATEX caps may be purchased through the NAC in

The league rules state that Non-residents may participate in dual meets as 'exhibition' entries, meaning that they may not score points. Therefore all non-resident swimmers are not eligible for the Regional Swim Meets.

Acceptable documentation includes: (Only one is required)

- Valid Driver's License (License number may be blackened out)
- Utility bill clearly stating both name and address

Additionally, if swimmer's last name differs from parent's last name a birth certificate is necessary for the swim league.

The Norwood Aquatics Club not only needs the help of our parents, but also that of our older swimmers (entering 7th Grade).
